## History

The HF was founded after the death of James McMillan or Mac (3<sup>rd</sup> April 1994). Phyl McMillan (Mac's wife) invited a group of people to meet in Bad Ragaz shortly afterwards in order to secure the

future of Halliwick according to Mac's wishes.

Those people are the board of HF as above and they formed the initial Steering Committee. This committee organised a meeting to form the IHA: International Halliwick Association. This meeting took place in December 1994.

It was intended, according to Mac's wishes, that no other people were to join the board of the HF and the HF members then took responsibility and joined various committees of the newly started IHA.

## Aims

HF has the following aims, defined at the first meeting in Bad Ragaz, December 1994, refined by Phyl McMillan (HF) and Mengi Mulchandani (Chair IHA), in Haderslev, April 1999 and completed by Hubert Haberfellner in 2000 as a preparation for the General Meeting in London.

HF:

- Holds the intellectual copyright and registration of the trademark of the Halliwick Concept (logos and name).
- Holds a global view of the Halliwick Concept in the way Mac has conceived it.
- Acts as an advisory body to the International Halliwick Association
- Monitors development and progress of the Halliwick Concept worldwide. This includes the responsibility for teaching materials (preservation and development)
- Acts as a mediator/arbitrator for possible conflict between IHA and members (countries or individuals)
- Administrates and controls the Memorial Fund

## Co-operation

The Foundation chairperson or the representative will have a non-voting membership of the IHA Executive Committee.

The HF will invite the Chairperson or the representative of IHA to the HF meetings as a non-voting member. An exception will be made when HF has to function as an arbiter between IHA and members (countries or individuals)

HF receives the Minutes from meetings of the Executive Committees and sub-committees.

The IHA Executive Committee receives the Minutes of the HF meetings.

Members of HF will have their expenses covered in the same way as IHA Executive members.

## Present situation

HF registered through a public notary at June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2004. Cases of misuse of the name Halliwick have made it necessary to register officially in order to be able to protect Halliwick and it's logos. European registration of the word Halliwick<sup>®</sup> is pending. Benelux registration has been completed at September 17<sup>th</sup>, 2003.

HF also digitalized original written information by Mac, as well as video's and slides. This will promote easier access to these information sources
